LIMITED SUB-LICENCE FOR RECONNAISSANCE SEISMIC DATA

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Seismic data acquired pursuant to operations conducted subject to the Petroleum (Production) Act 1934 and landward area regulations made in exercise of powers conferred thereby are Crown Copyright material. The UK Onshore Geophysical Library ("the Library"), pursuant to worldwide exclusive rights granted by The Controller of Her Majesty's Stationery Office ("the Controller") hereby grants

Example Oil & Gas Ltd

("The licensee")

a non-exclusive limited sub-licence ("Sub-Licence") to use the seismic data listed in the Schedule hereto ("Reconnaissance Data") on the following terms and conditions:

1.0 Reconnaissance Data - Definition and Sub-Licence Arrangements

- 1.1 Such Sub-Licence shall convey no rights of ownership over the seismic data and shall not entitle Licensee to gain access to original field tapes
- 1.2 Where Reconnaissance Data are currently archived by the Library they will be made available to Licensee for a period not to exceed two years at the rate of £15 per kilometre.
- 1.3 Where Reconnaissance Data are not part of the UKOGL archive, the price as defined in clause 1.2 will be supplemented by the cost of archiving.
- 1.4 Group escalation will apply to the Sub-Licence at the standard rate of £10 per kilometre per extra Group Member (as hereafter defined) where Licensee is part of a Joint Venture Group as defined under clause 2.6.
- 1.5 In the event that a UK onshore exploration and development licence ("PEDL") is awarded to Licensee or associate Group Member within the four year period following the purchase of the Sub-Licence, Licensee commits to upgrade to a full Sub-Licence all Reconnaissance Data that lie within the boundaries of the PEDL ("the Licence Area", and being determined as at the confirmation of award), by the payment of an additional £35 per kilometre within 30 days of the confirmation of award.
- 1.6 Subject to clause 1.5, Licensee may pay an additional £35 per kilometre at any time up to that date which is 30 days after the two year anniversary of the issuance of the Sub-Licence and obtain a full Sub-Licence in respect of any Reconnaissance Data.

- 1.7 No further escalation charge shall be payable by any Group Member on the acquisition of a full Sub-Licence under clause 1.5 or 1.6.
- 1.8 All Reconnaissance Data for which the additional payment to convert to a full Sub-Licence is not made under clause 1.5 or 1.6 shall be returned to the Library by the date which is 30 days after the two year anniversary of the purchase of the Sub-Licence, the actions set out in clause 4.3 shall be carried out and neither Licensee nor any Group Member shall have any further rights to use Reconnaissance Data
- 1.9 Licensee undertakes to notify the Library as soon as practicable when the award of a PEDL in respect of any part of the Licence Area takes place.
- 2.0 Ownership and Licence**
- 2.1 Title, copyright and all other proprietary rights in Reconnaissance Data remain the property of the Crown.
- 2.2 This Sub-Licence may not be transferred or assigned without the prior written consent of the Library.
- 2.3 Licensee is not permitted to trade Reconnaissance Data nor to use Reconnaissance Data to provide a service of any kind to a third party.
- 2.4 If Licensee permits access to Reconnaissance Data by any person not directly employed by Licensee, then Licensee shall be liable to the Controller and to the Library for any failure by such person to comply with these terms and conditions as they apply to the Licensee. Licensee may permit access to Reconnaissance Data by its professional consultants and its affiliated companies, provided that Licensee first obtains from such entities an undertaking of confidentiality in respect thereof.
- 2.5 Licensee may not copy, distribute or adapt Reconnaissance Data for other than its own internal and exclusive use unless the prior written consent of the Library has been obtained.
- 2.6 If Licensee is, or at any time hereafter becomes, the operator or a member of a bona fide licence bidding group, exploration group or exploitation group ("Joint Venture Group") Licensee may share the use of Reconnaissance Data with another member of such Joint Venture Group ("Group Member") providing:-
 - (a) the Library in its absolute discretion is satisfied that Licensee and Group Member are members of a Joint Venture Group; and

- (b) such Group Member has paid an escalation fee as defined under clause 1.4 and
- (c) such Group Member agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions to the same extent as Licensee.

3.0 Limitation of Liability

- 3.1 Neither the Crown nor the Library will be liable in contract or in tort for any loss, damage, expense or injury of any nature, whether or not such matter amounts to a fundamental breach of a fundamental contractual term, suffered by the Licensee or any other party as a result of the use of or reliance on any of Reconnaissance Data or of any errors or omissions in Reconnaissance Data or of any faults in the media on which Reconnaissance Data are recorded.
- 3.2 The Library disclaims all warranties express or implied, excluding but not limited to warranties of merchantability, quality or fitness for any purpose and non-infringement of third party rights in respect of Reconnaissance Data.
- 3.3 If any of the above provisions or portions thereof are invalid or unlawful under any applicable law, they are to that extent only deemed omitted.

4.0 Termination

- 4.1 Without prejudice to any other rights or remedies of the Library, the Library may terminate this Sub-Licence forthwith by written notice to Licensee if:
 - (a) Licensee commits a breach of this Sub-Licence and fails to remedy such breach within 30 days of a written notice from the Library specifying the breach, or
 - (b) Licensee goes into liquidation (except for amalgamation or reconstruction).

For the purpose of this sub-clause notice shall be deemed to have been served on the Licensee 48 hours after posting by first class post to the last address of Licensee known to the Library.

- 4.2 Termination shall not discharge Licensee from payment of any sums accrued due to the Library (whether or not invoiced) up to the date of termination, or entitle the Licensee to repayment of any such sum paid to the Library.
- 4.3 On termination of this Sub-Licence, Licensee and any Group Member which has acquired Reconnaissance Data under clause 1.4 shall cease to have any rights or Sub-Licence in respect of Reconnaissance Data or any adaptation thereof and shall cease to use the same and shall erase Reconnaissance Data or any adaptation thereof from any storage

apparatus and shall return to the Library without demand Reconnaissance Data and all existing copies thereof made by them and shall warrant in writing to the Library that all data, plots, displays, results, analyses, variations and modifications derived from Reconnaissance Data are destroyed.

5.0 Applicable Law

- 5.1 The Sub-Licence and the terms and conditions thereof shall be governed and construed in accordance with English Law.
